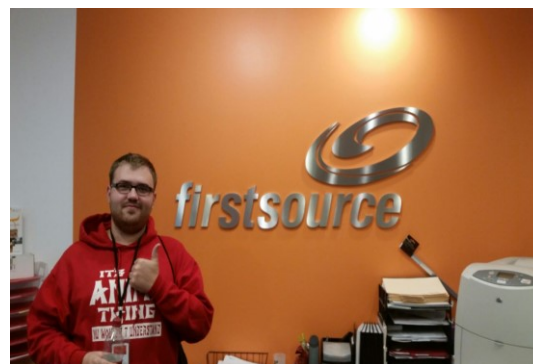
The month wrapped up with Halloween Parties at each of our centers. The costumes were amazing!
